BLUMENTHAL ARTS MISSION

To present the best in the performing arts and, in partnership with others, share and employ the arts as a major catalyst to strengthen education, build community cohesiveness, and advance economic growth.

JUNIOR THEATER CELEBRATION

Junior Theater Celebration Charlotte offers an enthusiastic, educational field trip experience for area students and teachers to interact with hundreds who share a similar passion for musical theatre in schools. The program was created and directed by iTheatrics, a premiere creative consultant in education-focused musical theater based in New York City, in association with the leading theatrical licensor Music Theatre International (MTI) and Blumenthal Arts' Education Department.

During the culminating spring celebration, each school group performs a short selection from their student-adapted musical production before a panel of guest artists who provide constructive feedback and suggestions to help the students expand on theater skills such as diction, projection, acting through song, blocking and physicality, or finding a connection to the piece.

Additionally, students participate in immersive workshops while teachers can opt into professional development training alongside iTheatrics teaching artists. Most importantly, Junior Theater Celebration Charlotte is the culminating event that brings together enthusiasts from different backgrounds and skill levels – from area students, teachers, and volunteers to experienced Broadway professionals – under one roof to spotlight and amplify the work that's been accomplished inside the classroom across many months. Thanks to generous support, this program has remained free to participating school groups.

SCHOOL PARTICIPATION

Blumenthal Arts invites public, private, and charter elementary and middle schools within the Greater Charlotte Region to apply for participation in the 2026 Junior Theater Celebration Charlotte program. Space is filled on a first-come, first-served basis to the first 48 eligible schools to apply.

- Registration is open to Elementary and Middle Schools.
- Registration is first-come, first-served with a capacity of 48 schools; 16 schools per festival day.
- Participating schools will present a student performance of a 5-minute selection for a musical; large ensemble numbers preferred.
- Schools must provide a digital instrumental track for their performance selection.
- A 5-minute song mash-up from a show is permitted; schools are responsible for curating and providing the final instrumental track before the festival.
- Schools must have valid show licensing for the musical presented.
- Only student-adapted versions of musicals qualify for participation (Jr., Kids, Young at Part, G2K, etc...).
- Registered schools will receive notice with their assigned participation day. Blumenthal Arts cannot accommodate date change requests once confirmed.
- Schools must arrange transportation and be available for the duration of the festival day from 8:30am-4:30pm.

ABOUT THE CELEBRATION

The annual Junior Theater Celebration Charlotte will be held at the Belk Theater March 24-26, 2026. Schools will be assigned to one day of the three-day festival. A detailed daily schedule will be provided in advance of the festival. Each school will be assigned liaisons to guide them to different festival activities according to the schedule. The festival includes:

- A high-energy field trip in a supportive, student-centered environment that brings together students, educators, and industry professionals in a celebration of musical theater.
- An opportunity for students to perform on a Broadway touring stage.
- Feedback for the New York based iTheatrics team, comprised of Broadway industry professionals.
- Student workshops with industry professionals.
- Teacher workshops with industry professionals.

AWARDS

Schools receive ribbons for every student, all-star student awards, and school participation certificates.

FEES/TICKETS

There is no participation or application fee for Junior Theater Celebration Charlotte.

SCHOOL CONTACT PERSON / COMMUNICATION

1. The school contact person is the individual to whom all Junior Theater Celebration correspondence will be addressed. This individual is required to have access to e-mail and phone calls between the time of registration and the festival.
2. The contact person must meet all deadlines including form completion and communication response times.

SHOW KIT REIMBURSEMENT

Blumenthal Arts is proud to support elementary and middle school musicals and plays that participate in the **Junior Theatre Celebration (JTC)**. Production Licensing Subsidies help offset costs so more young people can access high-quality theatre experiences.

- **Who can apply:** CMS and regional K–12 public, charter, or private schools participating in the current JTC cycle. *Note: These awards are needs based and typically private schools are not awarded.*
- **Award Amount:** Amounts vary based on funding pool, demonstrated need and project scope.
- **Use of funds:** Reimbursement for approved show licensing fees only. A copy of the licensing agreement and proof of payment are required.
- A link to the Show Kit Subsidy Application will be provided to schools after they have submitted their application to participate.
- **Deadline: November 24, 2025.** Notifications by **December 15, 2025.**

PHOTO REQUIREMENTS

Participating schools are REQUIRED to provide quality, high resolution, digital, color photos in JPEG format that represent their production. Please include the school or individual's name in the file name. The following photos are mandatory and are due Tuesday, March 10, 2026

- Full cast photo.
- 10-15 production photos including process photos of rehearsal, crew working/building, final dress rehearsals, etc.

FESTIVAL PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEOGRAPHY POLICY

Photos: Allowed (no flash, no distractions).

Videos: Allowed for **personal/non-distribution use only**.

Permissions: If students/staff cannot be photographed for internal/social media purposes, notify the Blumenthal Arts School Impact Manager at least 5 business days before the festival.

TRANSPORTATION, PARKING & ARRIVAL

- Check-In: 8:00–8:30 AM at the Belk Theater (130 N. Tryon Street).
- Drop-Off: Buses, vans, or cars may drop off students at the theater entrance but cannot park there.
- Bus Parking:
 - TBD – offsite parking will be provided for buses and vans only. Please note parking is 9 blocks away.
- Parents: Must find their own parking (Bank of America garage or nearby surface lots).

WHAT TO BRING

Lunch:

- Option 1: Students/chaperones bring packed lunches.
- Option 2: Arrange group delivery.
- Outdoor courtyard dining if weather permits; otherwise, lobby spaces.

Music:

- Bring your track on a **phone or tablet** for warm-up.
- Recommended: backup copy on flash drive or second device.

Attire:

- Sneakers/closed-toed shoes for movement.
- Show shirts or school T-shirts encouraged.

PARENT VIEWING

Parents may attend performances in the theater; they are not permitted to sit in on workshops.

- **Seating:** Parents watch from the **Mezzanine** (orchestra level reserved for schools).
- **Check-In:** Required with Front of House Manager or Blumenthal Education staff.
- **Parking:** Parents responsible for their own arrangements.
