Blumenthal's Open Mic invites local performing artists of all experience levels to perform on a Blumenthal stage. Instrumentalists, singers, dancers, storytellers, poets, jugglers, magicians, and all other performers are welcome! We accept performers and spectators of all ages.

Due to great interest, we have implemented a lottery system to select performers. Around 2 weeks before an event, an email will be sent to everyone in the email club that includes a survey link to request a performance slot. Everyone who requests a performance slot will be contacted 8 days prior to the event to let you know if you've been selected. If you're not selected to perform at the upcoming event, please feel free to attend as an audience member and submit your act next time for another Open Mic!



### Please remember:

- Performances must be no longer than 5 minutes.
- Performances must be appropriate for a general audience including very young children.
- Performances must stay within the stage dimensions: 33' wide X 18' deep.
- Each performer or group must be able to set up the stage for their act within 90 seconds and clear the stage of their items within the same amount of time.



Blumenthal can provide up to 5 microphones, a CD player, an auxiliary cord (to connect to a phone or mp3 player via headphone jack), 1 DI box and cord for instrument amplification (1/4" plug), chairs and stools. Tech requests for your act must be submitted through the survey when requesting a performance slot.
